


COLLEGE PARK COMMUNITY FOOD BANK

About the College Park Community Food Bank: Established in September 2008 as a ministry of the College Park Church of the Nazarene, the food bank became an independent nonprofit in 2021. It is fueled by support from the local community in the form of donations of money, food items and volunteers. In turn, the food bank provides food to any person or family in need without qualification. During the pandemic, the nonprofit expanded its modest operation to serve more than ten times the families served in pre-pandemic times. It is currently supporting an average of 341 families a week and is on track to distribute over 25,000 food packages in 2024. This is only possible because of the support it receives from the community.
